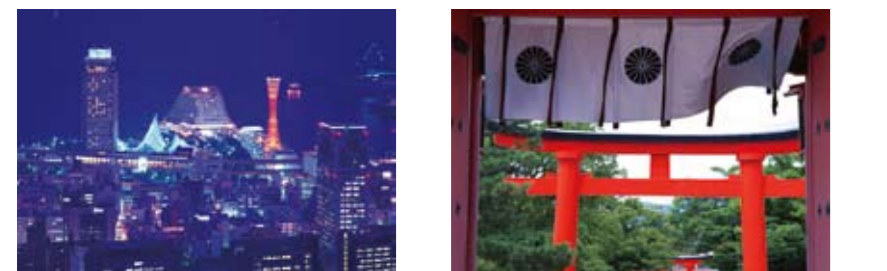


About Osaka

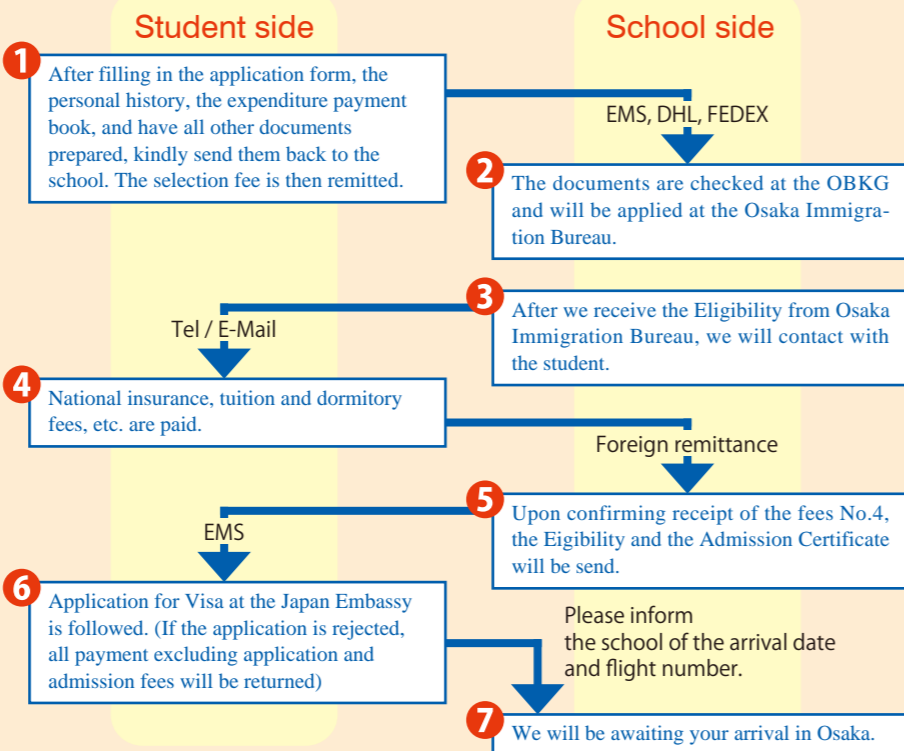

シラバス・授業内容

初級クラス	漢字 300 ～ 500 字、語彙 1500 語程度習得 初級文法、簡単な日常会話、初歩的な作文、日本人と交流するために、日常生活での挨拶から始めるための細かい教育を行います。易しい文法・楽しい会話から出発、聴解・語彙・発音・漢字・作文などの表現方法も学びます。それぞれの目標に合わせた、合理的で楽しい授業です。
中級クラス	漢字 1000 ～ 1500 字、語彙 6000 語程度習得 日本留学試験対策授業、日本語能力試験対策授業、論述指導、日本の大学に進学するため、本格的に文法・句型についての授業を始めます。
上級クラス	漢字 2000 ～ 2200 字、語彙 10000 ～ 12000 語程度習得 日本留学試験対策、日本語能力試験対策、日本の新聞・専門書・文献などの研究を通して、日本語での講義を十分理解できるようにし、高等教育機関・有名大学への進学準備を行います。大学院受験のための研究テーマ等の論文作成指導も行っています。

入学時にレベル試験を行い、クラスを決めます。

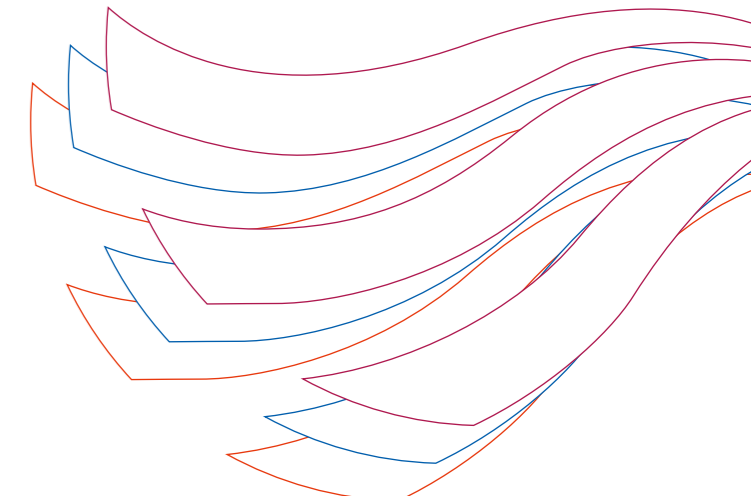
進路指導について

School Features

OBKG has 4 enrollment period every year. In one to two years, we assist students in preparing proficiency for Academic Japanese.

Beginner Classes are offered in Jan, Apr, July, and Oct.

Applicant with Japanese Language Proficiency Test Level 4 or higher will be able to enroll at any time.

Syllabus content

Beginner Class	300-500 kanji characters 1500 basic vocabulary Lessons involve introducing simple daily conversation and fundamental writing, which will eventually advance so that students could interact with the locals. From basic grammars and simple dialogs, along with kanji writing, hearing, and pronunciation practice, students learn ways to better express themselves through the language. These tailored lessons are to correspond to respective goals and classes are bound to be pleasant.
Intermediate Class	1000-1500 kanji characters 6000 vocabulary The intermediate class involves exam preparation (JLPT, EJU, college/university entry test), where students will be learning correct grammar and sentence structure in depth. Students will also be given guidance on dissertation writing to be ready for college and university.
Advance Class	2000-2200 kanji characters 10000-12000 vocabulary Exam preparation lessons continue. The school will be focusing on comprehension by teaching students from local newspaper reading to understanding literature and certain technical terms. The syllabus is to ensure that students are capable of understanding the lectures performed in Japanese as they continue into university or any other institution of higher education in Japan. Students will also be given guidance on dissertation compilation like research themes and thesis writing, which are part of the examinations in graduate schools.

Classes

Four hours per day, from Monday through Friday, 20hours a week, 800hours of classes per year.

- Morning classes: 9:00a.m.to 12:50p.m.
- Afternoon classes: 1:10p.m.to 4:50p.m.

According to the student' s Japanese proficiency, will be divided into a.m and p.m classes.

Completion of 12 years of formal school education or equivalent.

Class Division

During OBKG opening, there will be a placement-test for students Japanese level, and from there we will determine which class is best for each student.

Counseling on Further Education

We try our best to help students with plans to further their studies in Japan after graduating from our school. Class teacher, along with the school headmaster will give guidance to students personally according to every student' s academic backgrounds and individual abilities. From choosing the right school to writing the entry essay (statement of reasons for aspiring to enter college/university), filling in the application forms, even interview practices will be discussed and guided individually.

Information

Location

Our school is located within a five minutes walking from both Temma Station of JR Loop Line and Ogimachi Station of Sakaisuiji Subway Line. The surrounding area is quiet and peaceful, creating a good study environment which enhances students' learning efficiency. Students may always drop by for a change of atmosphere, to relax after class, or to mingle with friends at nearby three large parks. It is a 2minutes walk to the Tenjinbashi-suji Shotengai, the longest shopping street in Japan and 10minutes walk to the Sakuranomiya Park, the places of interest for SAKURA, and one of the three major festivals. Tenjin Festival, will be held in Tenmangu which again is only 5minutes walking distance from OBKG.



Living in Japan

Our staff will always be at your assistance for foreigner registration (applying for alien card), submission to the immigration, Visa updates, or even escort to clinic/hospital in case of medical needs. We hope that our students could feel at safe and have a pleasant experience studying abroad in Japan.
